




Here's to 2020, a new year, a new beginning, a year for building on the positives of the previous decade towards better times ahead.






















They say change is the only thing that is constant. But every new beginning owes its birth to something that came before it. As children (and adults), this is how we learn and grow: building upon what we have experienced before.






Typewriter







Floppy Disk Disk

The first commercial storage device "The floppy disk", developed in the late 1960s, was 8 inches (200 mm) in diameter and could hold a total data of 175 KB; they became commercially available in 1971 as a component of IBM products and they were sold separately beginning in 1972 by Memorex and others. Super 8mm Video Camera

Super 8mm film cameras were first manufactured in 1965 by Kodak for their newly introduced amateur film format, which replaced the Standard 8 mm film format. Manufacturing continued until the rise in popularity of video cameras in the mid-1970s. During the late 1960s, cameras were only filmed at 18 frames per second, but in years to come, speeds such as 24 frames/s became more common. Let's fast forward directly to the I phone in your hand and you will realise that it can shoot videos with 4K resolution at 24 fps, 30 fps, and even 60 fps.

Cassette Tape Recorder

Another format that made an impact on culture in the 1980s was the radio-cassette, aka the "boom box" (a name commonly used only in English-speaking North America), which combined the portable cassette deck with a radio tuner and speaker/s capable of producing significant sound levels. These devices became synonymous with urban youth culture in entertainment, which led to the somewhat derisive nickname "ghetto blaster." The boom box allowed people to enjoy music on the go and share it with friends. This also led to such cultural practices as breakdancing.



SLR Camera

A single-lens reflex camera (SLR) is a camera that typically uses a mirror and prism system (hence "reflex" from the mirror's reflection) that permits the photographer to view through the lens and see exactly what will be captured. Dating back to the first quarter of the 20th century, the 35mm format has mostly given way to today's digital still and video technologies. The 35mm film frame is 36 x 24mm, and high-end digital SLR (DSLR) and video cameras use sensors of equivalent size.







Cellular Phone

Martin Cooper was the first person to make an analog cellular mobile phone in the year 1973, however, it was not available for commercial use until 1984. Motorola DynaTAC 8000x was the first commercially available cellular phone launched in 1984 and was considered small enough to be easily carried. This mobile unit was very large compared to phones today it weighed 790 g and was 10 inches (25 cm) high. You would have to shell out \$3,995 (about \$10300 in 2019) to acquire a single unit. Today in 100\$'s you could own a cell phone that is not only a cellular phone but a smart device that lets you do everything a fully-featured computer could do.

Gramophone

The phonograph was invented in 1877 by Thomas Edison. Alexander Graham Bell's Volta Laboratory made several improvements in the 1880s and introduced the graphophone, including the use of wax-coated cardboard cylinders and a cutting stylus that moved from side to side in a zigzag groove around the record. In the 1890s, Emile Berliner initiated the transition from phonograph cylinders to flat discs with a spiral groove running from the periphery to near the center, coining the term gramophone for disc record players. All phonograph records had the playing time of a 12-inch diameter record to less than five minutes per side. Now you carry a never-ending collection of music from all genres on your handheld device. We live in a world of streaming and listen to whatever we wish to listen to by a single tap on our screen.



Personal Computer

The IBM Personal Computer, commonly known as the IBM PC, is the original version of the IBM PC compatible hardware platform. It is IBM model number 5150 and was introduced on August 12, 1981. Pricing started at US\$1,565 (equivalent to \$4,401 in 2019) for a configuration with 16K RAM, Color Graphics Adapter, and no disk drives. it became a device of popular choice for many people. The impact of the Apple II and the IBM PC was fully demonstrated when Time named the home computer the "Machine of the Year", or Person of the Year for 1982 (3 January 1983, "The Computer Moves In"). It was the first time in the history of the magazine that an inanimate object was given this award.



Telephone



Television

Introduced in the late 1920s in mechanical form, television set became a popular consumer product after World War II in electronic form, using cathode ray tubes. The addition of color to broadcast television after 1953 further increased the popularity of television sets and an outdoor antenna became a common feature of suburban homes. The invention of the television was the work of many individuals in the late 19th and early 20th centuries. Individuals and corporations competed in various parts of the world to deliver a device that superseded previous technology. The world's first 625-line television standard was designed in the Soviet Union in 1944 and became a national standard in 1946. The first broadcast in the 625-line standard occurred in 1948 in Moscow.
